

# **Communications Workers Local 54041/NABET-CWA Local 41 2025 Officer Election Nomination Notice**

Pursuant to a voluntary compliance agreement signed on November 16, 2023, and amended on April 3, 2024, Communications Workers Local 54041/NABET-CWA Local 41 (Local 41) will conduct new nominations and a new election for the offices of president, vice president, treasurer, and secretary under the supervision of the Secretary of Labor in accordance with Title IV of the Labor-Management Reporting and Disclosure Act of 1959, and insofar as lawful and practicable, with the union's constitution and bylaws.

Officers will be installed within a week following their election and will serve a full 3-year term ending in March 2028.

## **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

Nominees, nominators, and nomination witnesses must be in good standing as defined in Article IV, Section 4 of the Local 41 Bylaws and Article II of the NABET-CWA Bylaws. Members who have been deprived of good standing as a result of a trial conducted in accordance with Article X of the NABET-CWA Sector Bylaws, revised July 8, 2023, shall not be eligible to hold office.

In accordance with NABET-CWA Local 41 Bylaws, revised September 2020, Article IV, Section 4(b): No member shall simultaneously hold more than one of the following local offices: President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, or Steward. Should a member be appointed or elected to more than one office, that member shall at once resign all offices except one. This paragraph shall not apply to those appointed to temporarily fill such offices by reason of resignation, recall, death, disqualification, or inability to act. Bylaws do not prevent a member from being a candidate for an office while holding another office.

## **NOMINATING PETITION DEADLINE**

Nominating petitions for Officers must be received by the Election Supervisor by no later than 5:00 PM (Central) on February 10, 2025.

Nominating petitions must be submitted by mail, email, or in person to the Election Supervisor (see mailing address and email address at the top of page 2). Submitting nominating petitions by email is encouraged. The Office of Labor-Management Standards (OLMS), Chicago District Office is open Monday through Friday from 8:30 AM to 5:00 PM (Central).

- Print your name, the name of the nominee, and the title of the Office.
- The nominator must sign their name on the nominating petition.
- The nominator and nominee must be an active member in good standing of Local 41.
- The nominee must sign the nominating petition, while being witnessed by another Local 41 member.
- The witness must sign the nominating petition.
- Self-nominations are not permitted.
